The Public Interest Media Project, Inc., is working to educate the general public to the effective use of mass communications media. To this end, we hold discussion groups at various locations, and irregular intervals, on topics such as: "How can the Media be improved?"; "What can and should an individual do to get messages across to the general public through the mass media?"; "How can relations between community groups and media owners and managers be improved?". Another aim of the organization is to disseminate information and to provide training relevant to the effective use of the Media. To this end, we are currently writing and publishing a series of booklets to be distributed free of charge, concerning "How To Utilize The Media." We are working to write and produce films and video tapes on similar subjects. We are also holding training workshops and seminars (also free of charge) on various skills necessary to the effective use of the mass media by the general public, such as portable video-taping skills, audio-tape production skills, writing skills, and reporting skills. We function as a nerve center, trying to keep aware of the opportunities available for access to various media, and trying to "plug in" individuals and groups who might be able to make use of such specific opportunities as: access to a TV or radio talk show, or an open-air discussion program; access to a newspaper looking for a specific article, and so forth. To become fully operation, and office full-time staff, various pieces of media a. These developments require production equipment, ordines, and an artist funding, which in turn repaires containing tax-exampt status. We are ready to

proceed with our fund-raining activities, and to operationalize the program, at our earliest opportunity.
